It is the mission of our Substance Use Disorder Treatment to ensure all clients receive appropriate and coordinated care to address Substance Use Disorders (SUDs) along with any Co-Occurring Disorders (CODs), whether they relate to mental health diagnoses, trauma, and/or criminal behavior.

Who is substance use treatment for?

Growth Works' treatment program consists of care that spans the needs of those who have curiosity surrounding mood altering substances and the impact their use has had in their lives; to those that have awareness that their use is out of control. There are also others who are practicing recovery but may still benefit from additional support.

Assessment

Admission to services is based on a completed assessment for both adults and adolescents. Information is collected to better understand the individual's history of substance use, strengths, and needs.

If they meet the criteria for the program, they may be placed in one of the following programs:

Intensive Outpatient Treatment

Adolescent

- Group Session | 3x week - 2 hrs/group

Outpatient Treatment

Adolescent

- Group Session | 2x week - 2 hrs/group

Adult

- Group Session | 1x week - 2 hrs/group
- Individual Session | 1x week - 1 hr/week

Relapse Prevention

Adult

- Group Session | 1x week - 2hrs/group

Parent Groups

- Group Session | 1x week - 2 hrs/group
- SUD concepts
- Impact use has on adolescent development

Topics for Discussion Include:

- Emotional Regulation
- Healthy Boundaries and Communication
- Identify Triggers
- Coping Skills

Fee for Service

While you are enrolled in services, you will be assessed a monthly \$25 fee for drug screens.

Additional fees may be assessed should you not attend services or planned appointments. If you reside outside of Wayne County, fees for services will be discussed at the time of intake.



Residential

Growth Works provides substance use and trauma treatment in partnership with Crossroads for Youth. Two programs, one for girls and one for boys, provide intensive services within an open, non-secure facility operated by Crossroads for Youth.

Youth in the program receive daily didactic sessions, group therapy 5x weekly, and individual and family sessions.

Also provided are recovery coaching support, life skills training, and trauma-informed yoga. Crossroads for Youth provides onsite schooling, medical care, and psychiatric support.
