



## Peer Recovery Coaching

### Program Description:

The Growth Works' Peer Recovery Coaching training is a high-level overview of the Peer Recovery Coaching program, what sets Growth Works apart in the industry, including the relationships we build and foster, our methods of pairing patients with Coaches who have similar lived experience, how we work together as a team throughout our organization, and how we advocate for recovery in Wayne County.

### Intended Audience:

- The Peer Recovery Coaching training is intended for organizations and nonprofits who are seeking more information on Growth Works' Peer Recovery Coaching team, how we run our program, and the positive impact we have had within Wayne County.
- This training is also intended for police and fire departments who may come into contact with individuals who may be struggling with alcohol or drug abuse or addiction.
- Judges and other members of the court system in Wayne County who come into contact with individuals who may be struggling with alcohol or drug abuse/addiction may benefit from this training as well.
