PROGRAMS & SERVICES

Supervised Parenting

The Supervised Parenting Program was created to give families a place for a child to visit with a parent in a safe and supervised setting. The Growth Works Supervised Parenting program provides a safe and trauma-informed space where trained staff help facilitate visits between children and parents. Our staff work closely with families to ensure safety, promote positive interactions and relationships.

Family Pathways

At Growth Works we understand the complex dynamics and needs that exist with families who have experienced intimate partner violence and/or child abuse. Growth Works services are designed to increase and maintain physical and emotional safety and support the overall well-being of all participants. Family Pathways provides supervised visitation with no fees to families where there have been allegations of intimate partner violence and/or sexual abuse.

Parent Engagement

Parent Engagement Workshops are a weekly forum conducted by experienced staff for parents/caregivers to receive information on important topics, and learn practical skills that can be applied to everyday life.

Community Resources

FASE Case Managers work with families and their individual needs to provide referrals to necessary resources in the community such as food, shelter, counseling, and legal aid.

Community Closet

Growth Works has developed a Mobile Community Closet to help provide essential items, such as hygiene products, toys, household items, clothes, and more to families in need for free, and with the support of staff members, community organizations and non-profits, we have been able to grow the closet to serve individuals and families throughout the year.

Third Circuit Court Training

FASE in partnership with First Step and Third Circuit Court Family Division made possible through the Justice For Families Grant provides education to the entire Family Division of Wayne County 3rd Circuit Court. Trainings focus on the dynamics of intimate partner violence, survivors navigating the court system and providing empathy for survivors and families.
